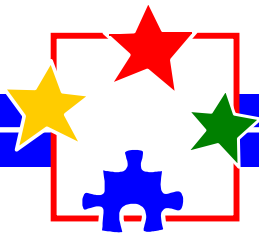

Language Checklist

<u>Age</u>	<u>Language Level</u>
Birth - 3 months	Cries differently depending on the circumstances; coos in response to your voice.
3 - 5 months	Babbles randomly at first, then rhythmically.
6 - 11 months	Babbles in imitation of real speech, with expression.
12 - 18 months	Says first words & expands vocabulary to 75 words; recognizes name; imitates familiar sounds; understands simple instructions.
1 - 2 years	Says 2-word phrases; vocabulary grows; waves goodbye; makes animal sounds; uses words to express wants; understands "no."
2 - 3 years	Identifies body parts; calls self "me" instead of name; combines nouns & verbs; has a 450 word vocabulary; uses short sentences; matches 3 - 4 colors; knows big & little; likes to hear same story repeated; uses plurals.
3 - 4 years	Can tell a story; vocabulary of about 1000 words; knows last name; several nursery rhymes.
4 - 5 years	Sentence length of 4 - 5 words; uses past tense; vocabulary of about 1500 words; identifies colors and shapes; asks questions (why and who).
5 - 6 years	Sentence length of 5 - 6 words; vocabulary of about 2000 words; knows spatial relations (on and behind); knows address; left & right hand; identifies same & different.

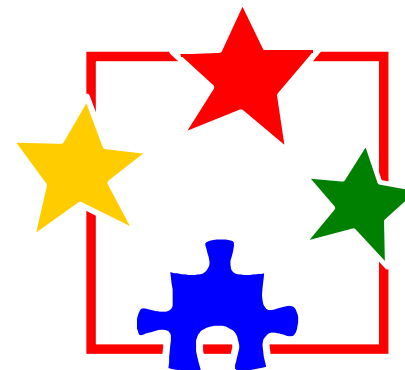
